Information Sharing

Information sharing is important to the LRC's public-service mission. The agency is committed to providing informational brochures and publications while being vigilant about the costs. To ensure that the LRC remains a good steward of taxpayer money, the agency has established policies for filling publication requests outlined in this brochure.

- ***Educational institutions can receive up to 100 complimentary copies of an LRC publication.***
- ***State agencies can receive up to 50 complimentary copies of an LRC publication.***
- ***Members of the general public, including lobbyists and trade groups, can receive up to 10 complimentary copies of an LRC publication.***





All publication requests from educational institutions and state agencies must be made in writing on official letterhead or sent via an official work email account. The correspondence must include the name of the requester, the shipping address, the publication being requested, the quantity needed and the preferred delivery deadline.

Publication Requests

The LRC will cover standard ground shipping on requests meeting this limit but not overnight, next-day and two-day shipping.

Walk-in customers to the LRC Publications Office can also request up to 10 free copies of any one publication during standard business hours.

The LRC Director's Office has to approve all requests that exceed the preapproved numbers.
